



## PUBLIC NOTICE

Please be reminded that the Bahamas Bureau of Standards and Quality (BBSQ) has appointed EAA Company Limited (EAA) as an accredited inspection company for a Pre-shipment Verification of Conformity (PVoC) program for the roadworthiness of used vehicles imported to the Bahamas.

All used vehicles arriving in the Bahamas and shipped from Japan, the United Kingdom, Singapore, and the United Arab Emirates, require an EAA pre-shipment inspection certificate of conformity (COC) to comply with import regulations on arrival in the Bahamas.

Please note that any vehicles arriving without the pre-requisite certificate of conformity will be refused entry into the Bahamas. The vehicle will then need to be re-exported, or alternatively scrapped.

Requirements for a valid EAA certificate of compliance are:

### Vehicle age limits

- Cars, Motorcycles and Light Commercial: Not exceeding 10 years
- Commercial Vehicles (exceeding 3,000 kg): Not exceeding 12 years

### Vehicle Drive

- Can be either right-hand or left-hand drive

### Pass a Radiation Inspection

- Relative to Japan and UAE Exports only

### Emissions

- Must pass an emissions test

### Roadworthiness Inspection

- Conform to BBSQ inspection standard for roadworthiness (BBSQ: 1001)
